Requirements and Responsibilities:

- Board Certification (BCBA or BCaBA)
- Administer assessments including but not limited to VB MAPP, Essentials for Living, AFLS, ABLLS, and PDDBI
- Create and modify individualized treatment plans for each child on caseload
- Observe client during treatment, compile and evaluate data on client responses to treatments and progress • Conducts functional assessments and analyses • Create behavior plans for each child on caseload as needed, monitors implementation, and provides feedback as necessary • Creates and supervises implementation of new programs
- Train, supervise, provide feedback and coaching for all RBTs on ABA and child's program under the direction of the Clinical Director
- Attends and participates in parent team meetings, therapist meetings, trainings, professional development and other meetings as needed
